
Dear Mr. Long:

We are in receipt of your letter dated July 19, 2011, to the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), in which you requested termination of the Norfolk District's Department of the Army, State Programmatic General Permit, Commonwealth of Virginia (07-SPGP-01). This permit had been issued to you on June 2, 2011, for impacts to 263 linear feet of an unnamed tributary to Schenks Branch, for the construction of a box culvert, riprap scour protection, and a sewer line crossing, associated with the proposed McIntire Road Extended project in Charlottesville, Virginia. You have requested termination of the permit because the impacts authorized by that permit will not occur. You further indicate that you are evaluating construction options that will not impact waters of the U.S.

Based on this request, your 07-SPGP-01 permit authorization to perform work in waters of the U.S, together with all its general and special conditions, is hereby withdrawn and is no longer valid.

Provided no work will occur below ordinary high water in jurisdictional waters, no permit is required from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. However, please note that a permit may be required for any work in jurisdictional waters of the U.S., and you must obtain authorization prior to performing any such work.
