**Special Conditions** 

I hereby agree to the termination of the above-referenced VWP and 07-SPGP-01 permit authorizations and waive my right to a public hearing in accordance with § 62.1-44.14(5) of the Code of Virginia.

I certify that the permit authorizations are not undergoing Department of Environmental Quality enforcement action.

I certify under penalty of law that the activities and any required compensatory mitigation authorized by the VWP general permit and the 07-SPGP-01 will not occur. I understand that by submitting this notice of termination VDOT is no longer authorized to perform activities in surface waters in accordance with the VWP general permit and the 07-SPGP-01, and that performing activities in surface waters is unlawful where the activity is not authorized by a VWP or 07-SPGP-01 permit. I also understand that the submittal of this notice does not release VDOT from liability for any violations of this VWP general permit authorization or the 07-SPGP-01 authorization, nor does it allow VDOT to resume the permitted activities without reapplication and reauthorization.

Also, termination of the permit authorizations eliminates any Federal action for the project and, therefore, the requirements of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (16 U.S.C. 470f) and 36 CFR Part 800 are no longer applicable. Therefore, the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) executed in April, 2011 is null and void, and VDOT shall so notify the other signatories and consulting parties to the MOA in accordance with Stipulation XIII.B.
